

Cougar Club Meeting Minutes

J. Rupe reported that Cougar Club was approached by a new vendor to sell spirit wear. This vendor plans to open a Northview/Southview Clothing store in Mayberry in December. J. Rupe reported that the executive committee will meet with this vendor to discuss the matter further.
