Course Topics: French III builds upon previous language skills with an emphasis on communication of the language. This communication through conversation and written expression becomes more complex with the use of multiple tenses and increased vocabulary. Comprehension of the language and culture is facilitated through required readings and studies. **Honors Course**

Credit: These students will have additional reading and comprehension assignments. The evaluation materials will also have additional components.

Materials:

1. Allez, viens! Level III textbook – Must be covered with book cover – Bring everyday unless otherwise instructed
2. Allez, viens! Level III workbook – billed with fees
3. Binder of 1" with pockets and notebook paper
4. Pens and pencils daily

Grading:

1. A point system will be used. All work will be given a point value. This will include devoirs, interros, examens, oral work and projects. All make-up tests will be scheduled outside of class, within two days of the absence, according to the student handbook.

Grading Cont. 2. Routine homework will be from the workbook or textbook, which will be graded for completion and effort. All homework will be recorded for points daily. These daily assignments will not be accepted late. Oral participation is recorded daily and given a quarterly grade.

Grading Cont. 3. Paragraphs or project compositions will be graded for content and grammar according to a rubric. The use of online translators or devices is prohibited and considered cheating. Long term assignments will be accepted late with an appropriate point deduction.
